Chablis is known worldwide for its classic dry white wines. The combination of butter, nuts and minerals brings an elegant complexity to this outstanding wine.

**Barons De Rothschild (Lafite), Medoc, Bordeaux, France, 2004**

The climatic year was marked by an exceptional heat wave the first fortnight of August with temperatures exceeding 40°C together with low rainfall throughout the vegetative cycle. When tasted the wine proved to be particularly rich, intense and uncruous with nice rounded tannins that offered a convivial side to the wine at this very early stage.
